**Position** – 2<sup>nd</sup> Clarinet/Bass Clarinet (1 tenure-track position), beginning the 2022 season

**Audition Dates** – Wednesday, January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022

**Audition Location** – John J. Cali School of Music at Montclair State University, Montclair, NJ

**Application Deadline** - All applications must be received no later than December 1st, 2021 by 11:59pm EST.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Clarinet (With bass clarinet responsibilities.)

### Position Information

**Compensation** - All amounts listed below are for the 2022 season.

**Wages** - \$176.58/service - guaranteed minimum weekly wage of \$971.19, but weekly wage is often higher.

**Number of services** - Typically, a maximum of 8 services per week. Traditionally 60 - 70 services per season.

**Living Allowance** - \$40.50/day inclusive, paid in bi-weekly amounts in advance, only if the winning candidate's permanent address is more than 80 miles from The Glimmerglass Festival

**Travel** - up to 2000 round-trip miles (for one trip), paid at the current IRS rate to non-local players as above. Musicians living less than 80 miles from The Glimmerglass Festival are paid commuting mileage, at the current IRS rate.

**Pension** – 4.75% of wages.

**Season** – The season traditionally runs from late June through late August (8-10 weeks).

The Glimmerglass Festival is an Equal Employment Opportunity employer and welcomes all qualified applicants. Qualified applicants will receive fair and impartial consideration without regard to race, sex, color, religion, national origin, age, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability, veteran status, genetic data or any other legally protected status.
